

## Tucson Metro Soccer League Summer 2014 Registration Information

**DIVISIONS:** Premiere      Division 1      Over 40 (*new*)      Over 50  
**GAMES:**      Tuesdays and Thursdays – 10 games (weather permitting) beginning May 27  
**COST:**      \$50/per player

TMSL will begin its summer 2014 season on Tuesday, May 27. On-line registration will open on March 18. The deadline for registering a team will be Tues May 13 at 7pm

**Registration Procedure:** Registration is to be completed via the on-line registration website, [www.tmslregistration.com](http://www.tmslregistration.com). Through the website, fees can be paid (via PayPal), forms (waiver) *for players who did not play during the 2013/2014 regular season* can be e-signed, and copies of photo IDs and photos for player passes *for players new to the league* can be uploaded. Alternatively, any required paperwork and payments can be dropped off at the league office prior to the registration deadline. The league office will be open that night from 5:00 to 7:00 pm for dropping off registration fees and any required forms. The league office is located at 4651 N. First Avenue, Suite 204

In order for a team to be eligible to play in the Summer Season, it must have a minimum of eleven (11) players fully-registered by the registration deadline. The completed team registration must include the following:

- Complete on-line roster (with address and email for all players)
- Full payment for at least eleven players either via PayPal or cash, check or money order. We ask that, if paying by check, for initial registration, one check be submitted for the entire team.
- Player forms/on-line waivers for individuals who did not play in the 2013/2014 regular season (player registration forms can be found on the TMSL website at [www.tmslsoccer.com](http://www.tmslsoccer.com))
- A copy of a valid, government-issued photo ID for any player new to the league (paper copy or uploaded)
- A digital photo of any player new to the league. Photos must be a headshot. Pictures should be 640 x 480 or so and be on the order of 100kb and in no case be larger than 1mb and can be taken at the office (on any Wednesday evening), submitted on disk or other media, or uploaded via the league registration site.

Priority or preference will be given to returning teams. New teams will be registered based on a first come, first served basis after returning teams have been given preference.

Registration packets that are not complete will not be accepted. **We do not accept individual registrations prior to a complete team having been registered.** There are no exceptions.

**Games:** Weather and field availability permitting, we hope to play a ten match season. There is no guarantee we will play ten matches as summer weather is very unpredictable and field availability is unpredictable at this time. Regardless how many matches we play, there will not be refunds of registration fees.

Matches will be played on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 6:30 and 8:15 p.m. We will play 40 minute halves.

**Players:** Players must be at least 18 years of age at the time of registration for the Open Divisions and at least 40 years of age at the time of registration for the Over 40 Division and at least 50 years of age at the time of registration for the Over 50 Division .

**Fees:** Player registration fee is \$50.00 which includes insurance, USSF and ASSA fees. A refundable \$100 team bond is also required for any new teams to the league.

**Miscellaneous:** Team packet pick-up night (information and player passes) is scheduled for Tuesday evening, May 20 from 5:00 – 7:00 pm at the League office. All team packets must be picked up that evening by a team representative in order for your team to begin play as scheduled on Tuesday or Thursday May 27/29.
